Abstract:

An open call for public administrations to perform trials as subcontractors is published, where the applying public administrations and municipalities will be selected as additional subcontractors for evaluating and using the platform, based on specific criteria, such as amount and coverage of financial data, ambition of partner to engage its citizens, plan for the involvement of start-ups, SMEs and NGOs in the evaluation and use of the trial results, number of potential citizens and organizations involved in the trial, geographic distribution involving various European regions, languages, nationalities. The allocation of 30-50 Thousand Euros as budget for each of the trials is required and will be used by the selected partner for data provisioning, citizen engagement and evaluation. The trials will be comprehensively evaluated and documented as best practices for D7.7, Large-scale trial report including best-practices.

Executive Summary

As specified in the Grant Agreement, the call for the Large Scale trials was launched by the Central Administration of the Fraunhofer Society in Munich on the 28th of October. Prior to the launch of this call, an intensive collaboration between the OBEU Partners and the Fraunhofer Legal and Procurement Departments was successfully undertaken since July. The aim of this collaboration was to ensure that the text for the call serves the best interests of the project, while at the same time, ensuring compliance with Fraunhofer's legal and procurement regulations. The Central Administration of the Fraunhofer Society in Munich had to be involved because the total subcontracting amount for the large scale trials (149,937.50 Euros) exceeded a certain internal threshold and thus had to be directed to Fraunhofer's Central Administration.

The Procurement Department, after intensive collaboration with the legal department, published the call for the large scale trials in the following two sites:

- 2) Deutsche eVergabe (Website link: http://www.deutsche-evergabe.de/index.html). Applicants that will apply via Ted eNotices will be directed to the eVergabe site, in order to complete their application.

Interested candidates can submit their applications until the 20th of December 2016.

To ensure the thorough penetration of the target market, the message relating to the call for tender has been disseminated in six languages, i.e. English, German, French, Spanish, Greek and Czech, across different communication channels. Apart from the press channels of all partners, this was done using the website and social media. The partners have also been asked to use their individual networks to inform potential applicants, and a number of high-profile events have been visited to present the call for tender in the form of round-table discussions and presentations.

1Introduction

Based on the GA's text and in collaboration with the OBEU partners, the legal and procurement departments of Fraunhofer, we prepared the tender for the large scale trials. We deem that this tender will support the project's focus by giving to the interested applicants the opportunity to be funded and to test the OBEU platform, SaaS and related tools. Our goal is to test the impact of our innovative products and services produced within the contact of the project. Furthermore we aim to interact directly with one of our principal customer segments, i.e. the interested municipalities that aim to address the citizens's request for transparency and more active participation in decision making related to funds. Through this process, we aim to uncover insights in terms of better serving this customer segment and improving technical development aspects accordingly. We also want to explore the sustainability potential for OBEU and to establish synergies. Thus the large scale trials present a great opportunity to test, receive feedback, improve or modify product aspects and further develop our exploitation and sustainability strategy.

1.1 Contract Documents

At the end of the document, the contract notice can be found in English and German. The tender was published on time, as set by the OBEU GA.

1.2 Specification

For the text of the tender and the publication process, we had to comply with the Fraunhofer procedures. At the beginning of our tender it is highlighted that the project has received funding from the European Union's H2020 EU Research and Innovation Programme under Grant Agreement No 645833. Further items that are addressed in the tender's text are the following: tenderers' and process' description, purpose of the large scale trials, list of the elements of the trial package, useful links, project and platform description, selection criteria for the applicants, award criteria and proposed timetable.

The feedback received from the large scale trials will be used for the D7.7 "Large-scale trial report including best practices". The D7.7 is a Report (Dissemination level: Public) which must be submitted at the end of the Project, i.e. before the end of October 2017. Moreover the results from the large scale trials will provide added value for the Exploitation Impact Report (D8.7) as we will use the results and feedback of the trials in order to refine our exploitation strategy and further increase the project's impact.

The published tender text can be found at the end of the deliverable (Appendix A, Specification).



1.3 Timeline

The tender was sent from the Procurement Department on the 28th of October 2016 for publication. The GA's deadline was set for the end of October 2016. The deadline for submissions is at the 20th of December. The usual Fraunhofer procedure was applied, according to which the decided dates are shown at table 1.

2 Dissemination Activities

2.1 Introduction

To ensure the thorough penetration of the target market, a dissemination initiative has been planned. It was executed upon the finalization of the details surrounding the call for tender. The dissemination strategy consisted of an invitation and a press release that was translated and spread in the network of the consortium in six languages, an accompanying blogpost containing concrete instructions for potential applicants, and outreach in the form of talks and use of social media. Members of the OBEU consortium were furthermore asked to make use of their personal networks to spread the word.

2.2 Invitation

The invitation has been composed and translated in a joint effort by the consortium and designed by OKF DE. It contains the most essential pieces of information surrounding the call for tender, the services and tools offered to successful applicants, and the requirements to their applications. It directs interested parties to the blogpost which details further step-by-step instructions. It has been spread in the networks of the partners and remains available on the OpenBudgets.eu website in English, German, French, Czech, Greek, and Spanish. The links are available in table 2.




Fig. 1: Screenshot of the blogpost

The selected tenderers will receive guidance, technical support and mentoring from the OpenBudgets.eu Consortium members for the implementation of the large scale trials and during the whole process.

Furthermore the selected tenderers will define their own selected trials package, in agreement with the OpenBudgets.eu Consortium members. Thus they will have the opportunity to select which tools or parts of the platform, they are willing to test.

Agreement to provide feedback by completing documents such as questionnaires, to prepare documents and to provide relevant information, which will be used for D7.7 with the title "Large-scale trial report including best practices". The D7.7 is a Report (Dissemination level: Public) which must be submitted at the end of the Project, i.e. before the end of October 2017. In this context, the trials will be comprehensively evaluated and documented as best practices. Thus it is necessary that regular communication on a mutually agreed basis between the selected municipalities and project members will be maintained for the whole duration of the large scale trials.

The working language will be English and all the documents produced will be in English.

Purpose of the Large-scale trials for evaluating the OpenBudgets.eu platform

- 1. To assess the effectiveness, as well as the social and economic impact, of using the provided tools in terms of delivering their goals, as specified in the OpenBudgets.eu project's Grant Agreement.
- 2. To use and evaluate the OpenBudgets.eu platform, related tools, including the related components of the OpenSpending platform, to which the OpenBudgets.eu platform serves as an extension.

OpenBudgets.eu (OBEU) Project Description

OpenBudgets.eu is an EU funded project, aiming at supporting journalists, civil society organisations, NGOs, citizens and public administrations, by providing an overview of public spending, as well as tools and appropriate data and stories to advocate and fight for fiscal transparency. OpenBudgets.eu will provide an open-source software framework and accompanying SAAS (Software-As-A-Service) platform for supporting financial transparency, thus enhancing accountability within public sectors, and as a result preventing corruption. A key challenge addressed by OpenBudgets.eu is to provide a multi-stakeholder framework which is scalable, easy-to-use, flexible and attractive.

The core objectives of OpenBudgets.eu project are:

1. A semantic data model

This model will be used to integrate all relevant budget and transaction data, giving a predefined structure to the input data. This will enable the integration of data from different public sectors at different levels. This integration can then be exploited by comparing different datasets.

2. A library of visualisation tools

This library will enable stakeholders to visualise available data in different granularity and in different modalities (spatial, temporal, administrative). These tools will enable the scrutiny of data under different lenses, enabling stakeholders to explore any relevant budget allocation.

3. A library of data mining and comparative analysis tools

This library will enable the aggregation of existing data in order to obtain new outcomes and discover trends and patterns, and potentially forecasting budget measures.

4. A feedback and citizen engagement interface

This will enable users to discuss and give feed-back on the provided data, for example, suggesting different priorities for budgeting, or discussing a particular transaction.

The OpenBudgets.eu open-source framework and portal will integrate these components into a comprehensive portal. The framework will be deployed as a software-as-a-service for thousands of public administrations and millions of citizens.

OpenBudgets.eu Platform Description

This is an open call for public administrations to perform trials of the OBEU SAAS (Software-As-A-Service) Platform as subcontractors. The Openbudgets.eu Platform is currently under development. The goal is to use the feedback provided by the large scale trials to further develop the platform. Thus it will be in development during this time period. The platform has an attractive front end, where users can easily upload or export budget and transaction data. The back-end provides access to the different services, such as data analytics and visualizations tools, and the Knowledge Base. The Knowledge Base is built upon a Semantic Data Model. It contains all the budget and transaction data uploaded by data providers. Following the five-star deployment schema, this data is all structured upon the Semantic Data Model. The repository serves as a hub in the linked data cloud, where other data repositories can connect to it.

The financial data, coming from different public bodies and different jurisdictions, are integrated by the Data Collection and Mining services. Once integrated, the data can be mined and analyzed to discover patterns, trends, and anomalies. The platform provides the following services: semantic lifting, data optimisation, data analytics and mining, access and visualisation service, and feedback service.

- Semantic Lifting Budget and transaction data uploaded by public entities to the OpenBudgets.eu framework do not adhere to the schema as developed in Openbudgets.eu. Semantic lifting will turn the flat data into one format.
- 2. **Data Optimisation** These new semantic resources are processed for cleaning and link discovery.
- Data Analytics and Mining services The goal of OpenBudgets.eu is to provide its
 users with easy to use tools for comparative analysis and data mining. Different tools
 are built to perform temporal, spatial, and administrative comparative analysis and
 data mining operations.

- 4. **Access and Visualisation Services** The Access service provides a preview of the data directly from the knowledge base. The visualisation service contributes to the analysis and presentation of the data by providing off the shelf visualization tools on the platform.
- 5. The **Feedback Service** This service facilitates discussions on and comments to the data, analysis, and visualizations and allows users share these on social media. It has an automatic forwarding function to the public administrators concerned, so that they can be immediately informed of the analysis and feedback on the budget and spending data.

Target tenderers: Selection Criteria for the Applicants

Suitability criteria for tenderers

Fulfilment of these suitability criteria is considered essential for ensuring compliance with the tender's aim.

In order to have a maximum impact of the project, this task involves running 3 to 5 large scale trials involving European municipalities or regions as additional subcontractors for evaluating and using the platform. Thus tenderers that aim to publish their budget and spending data and want to engage with their citizens will be selected based on the following criteria:

- 1. The applicants should share documentation of the community's profile, including information such as number of inhabitants, financial and economic capacity.
- 2. PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA. Requirements: The applicant must provide a document, which will explicitly confirm that the existing data are publicly available. In case of data not publicly available, relevant authorizations must be provided. We do not intend to collect any personal data within OpenBudgets.eu. The interviews and discussions with peer-researchers, experts and stakeholders will be performed informally and gathered feedback would only be documented in completely anonymized manner. At no stage of the research and development cycle of OpenBudgets.eu we plan to store any personal information.
- 3. The participating communities will be responsible for managing their own personnel and resources, own and offered, in order to deliver the expected feedback and documents as defined in this tender.
